MUSEO ARTCHIVIO – museum of the Enamel History

Inaugurated October 6th 2018, and Situated in the splendid location of **Plaza della Libertà, historical center of Ponte St. Pietro (BG)**. On the east side there is the historical building with the Town hall and with a terrace on the river Brembo. On the west side a hanging garden with the Famedio. On the north side, there is a historical building of the years 30, of architecture rationalist and in a part of this building the **MUSEUM ARTCHIVIO**.

The structure includes:

- **The MUSEUM** or the Fire Enamel History, with the permanent exposure of artistic works to enamel, deriving from the whole world and with all the techniques. They are over a thousand of picked pieces, during 25 years from Attilio Compagnoni, Italian president of the CKI.
- **An ESPOSITION AREA**, for personal or collective or collective shows of various techniques.
- **An EDUCATIONAL AREA**, for meeting, lectures and symposium, for about 50 people, here they are exposed hundreds of enameled pieces that show the design of 1900.
- **A EDUCATIONAL LABORATORY**, for demonstrations and master class.
- **A LIBRARY** with over 800 volumes on the enamel art, the technique and history.

The Museum is visitable with free entrance and accompany visits, both on appointment with date and schedules to be defined, both the Saturday and Sunday afternoon, from the 16.00 at 18.30 o'clock. a phone call of notice is pleasant for the possible variation of the schedules.
